

Environmental Policy

Introduction

Environmental management at Frankis Solutions Ltd (FSL) is an integral part of our corporate ethos and has a dedicated responsibility programme. FSL will also address the following specific issues:

1. Energy use

2. Environmental responsibility of product

We consider the environmental impacts at all stages of our service delivery, from pre-tender stage through to contract execution and final handover.

3. Resource consumption

We will seek to address our impact on the environment through the adoption of an environmental procurement policy. We will conserve resources through efficient use and careful planning.

4. Recycling

We recognise our responsibility to recycle materials wherever possible.

5. Disposal of waste

We will minimise waste and wherever possible recycle materials. We will dispose of all waste through safe and responsible methods.

6. The supply chain

We will work with our key suppliers to ensure they recognise and reduce the environmental impact of their operation, products and transportation.

7. Training personnel

We will implement our policies through guidelines and training.

8. Objectives and targets
